2022 Accomplishments

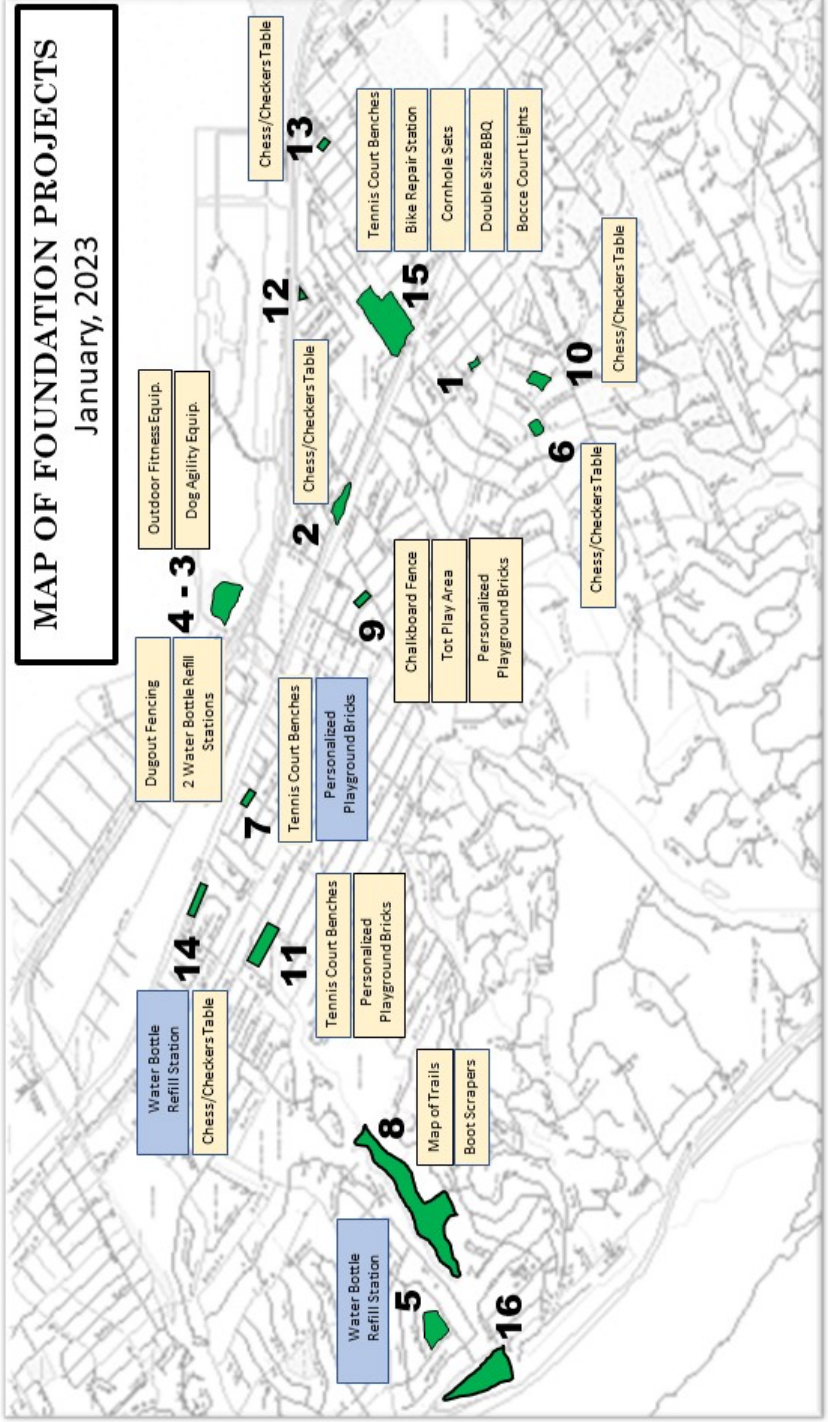
- Conducted a Bocce Ball Fun - Fundraiser
